Subject: Enhancement of INTERPOL's Retirement Plan

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Vienna, Austria, from 28 November to 1 December 2023, at its 91st session:

RECALLING Resolution AG-2004-RES-21, adopted by the General Assembly at its 73rd session (Cancun, 2004), establishing the Organization's internal pension scheme and creating the INTERPOL Pension Fund as a statutory fund; and Resolution AG-2022-RES-13, adopted by the General Assembly at its 90th session (India, 2022), approving the enhancement of the Organization's Defined Contribution Pension Scheme and tasking the General Secretariat to propose draft amendments to INTERPOL's legal framework,

ALSO RECALLING the Rules of the Organization's Retirement Plan approved by the Executive Committee at its 147th session (Berlin, 2005),

HAVING CONSIDERED Report GA-2023-91-REP-02 presented by the General Secretariat on the proposed amendments to the legal framework for the enhancement of INTERPOL's Retirement Plan, based on the fundamental principles and objectives endorsed by Resolution AG-2022-RES-13,

NOTING that these amendments have been proposed, in particular, on the basis of the recommendations made by the Executive Committee and the Advisory Group on Financial Matters, in line with the practice of other international organizations,

ENDORSES the General Secretariat's proposed amendments to the Staff Regulations and Financial Regulations;

APPROVES all of the amendments to the Staff Regulations and Financial Regulations as set out in Appendix 1 to Report GA-2023-91-REP-02;

DECIDES that the amendments to the Staff Regulations and Financial Regulations shall enter into force immediately at the close of the 91st session of the General Assembly.
